



Skunks Striped Skunk (*Mephitis mephitis*), Eastern Spotted Skunk (*Spilogale putorius*)

Instant ID

- Short-limbed mammal with two strong scent glands
- **Striped Skunk**: Thin, white stripe between eyes with two stripes running down the back, tali can have some to no white fur
- **Eastern Spotted Skunk**: Upside-down triangle on forehead and white -tipped tail with white spots on the body


Native Niches

- Striped skunk is found throughout Florida, except in the Florida Keys
- Eastern spotted skunk found in most of Florida
- Live in a wide variety of habitats, including woodlands and open fields

Favorite Foods

- Primarily feeds on insects (insectivore)
- Changes diet in winter and spring months
- Will eat fruits, vegetables and other animals

Critter Characteristics

- Musk from scent glands can blind some animals
- Can lose up to half its body weight in the winter

Population Protection

- · Populations of the eastern spotted skunk are declining
- Never touch wildlife, including skunks
