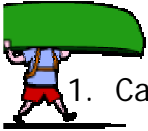






Top 25 Things To Do At WEKIWA SPRINGS STATE PARK

2. Swim or snorkel in the crystal, clear waters of Wekiwa Springs

4. Go fishing at sand lake (freshwater license required if 16 and older)
5. Bring your own horse and ride along our 8-mile equestrian trail
6. Look for deer and turkey, especially at dusk and dawn (please do not feed or approach the wildlife)
7. Bring the family and have a picnic 
8. Make sure the kids visit the playground
9. Take time to walk the "wet-to-dry" nature boardwalk (located next to the spring)
10. Soak up the sun on the slope 
11. Make reservations to camp in our family campground
12. Feeling more adventuresome? Make reservations at our primitive or canoe campsites
13. Ride your bicycle through the park
14. Go bird-watching (checklists available)
15. Take advantage of the photographic opportunities at Wekiwa
16. Rent a pavilion for the day (details at the ranger station)
17. Enjoy a game of volleyball or horseshoes
18. Take a break and relax at the butterfly garden 
19. Look for animal tracks along the trails
20. Read some of our informative kiosks located throughout the park
21. Look for evidence of recently burned areas
22. Take a nap on the slope
