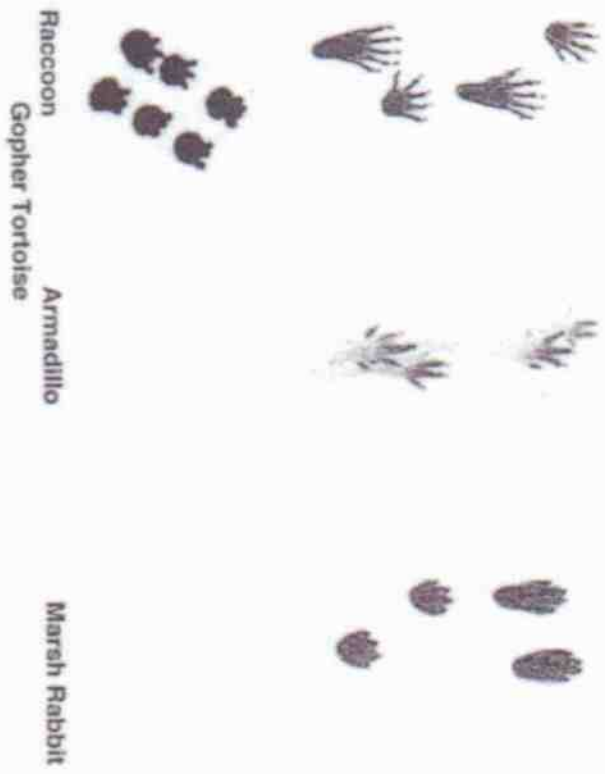


CALADESI ISLAND STATE PARK ISLAND TRAIL MAP and GUIDE

We invite you to walk along this trail and enjoy the variety of plant and animal life found along it. This 2.5-mile trail leads through the interior of the island. Points of interest along the way are noted by numbered posts and described by the corresponding numbered paragraphs in this guide. Please place this guide in the box at the end of the trail so that others may learn about Caladesi Island State Park. Do not disturb, damage, or molest plants or wildlife. Pets must be on a leash. Remember, free roaming dogs and rattlesnakes are a deadly combination. Snakes, tortoises and other wildlife should be observed from a distance. Please follow trail markers and do not use service roads or enter restricted areas.

A Note on Prescribed Burning: Many of the natural communities on the island are fire dependent. Controlled burning is a land management tool that reduces vegetative fuel for wildfires, recycles nutrients into the soil and has many other positive effects on the eco-system. As you walk you will notice areas which show the effects of these burns.
