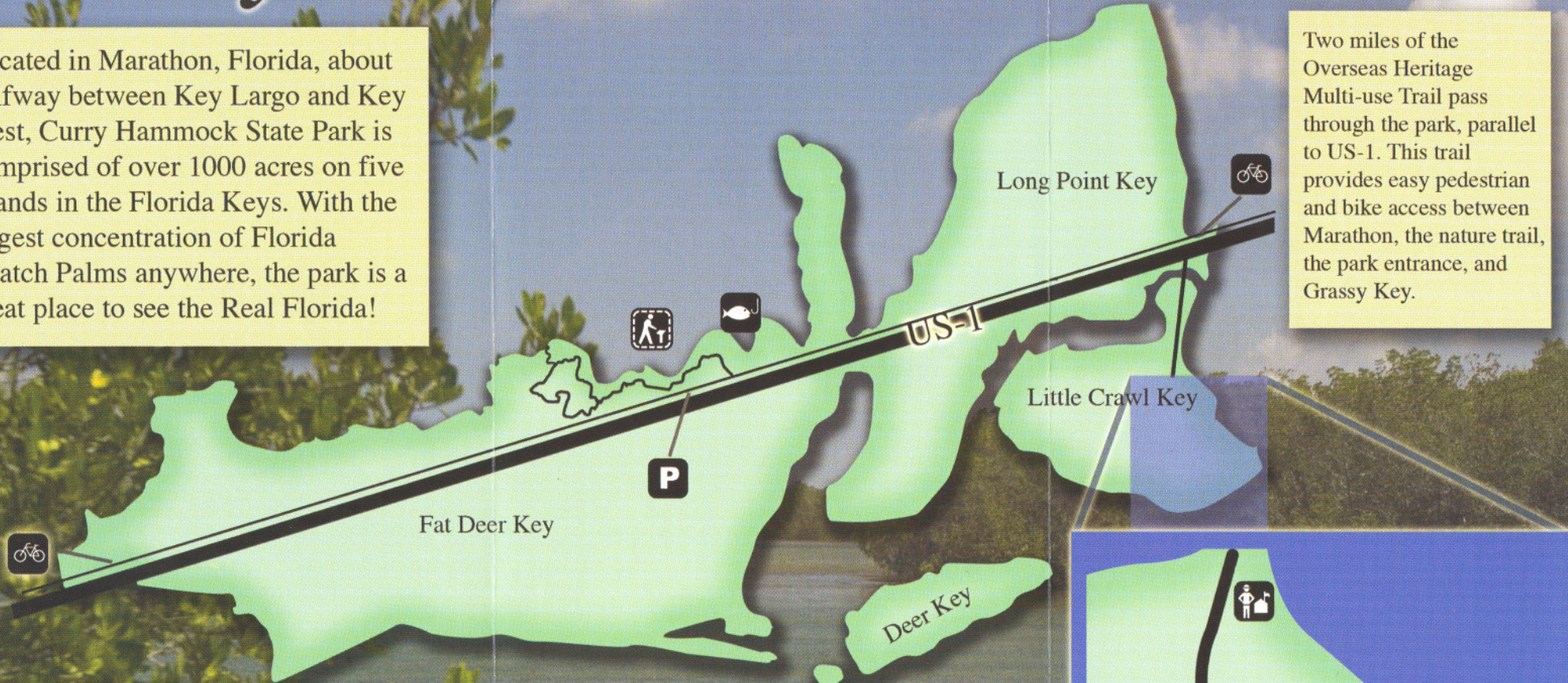


Curry Hammock State Park

Located in Marathon, Florida, about halfway between Key Largo and Key West, Curry Hammock State Park is comprised of over 1000 acres on five islands in the Florida Keys. With the largest concentration of Florida Thatch Palms anywhere, the park is a great place to see the Real Florida!

Two miles of the Overseas Heritage Multi-use Trail pass through the park, parallel to US-1. This trail provides easy pedestrian and bike access between Marathon, the nature trail, the park entrance, and Grassy Key.



The nature trail covers 1.5 miles of uneven terrain through a pristine tropical rockland hammock. A spur trail takes you to a secluded viewpoint of Florida Bay. The trailhead is located off US-1, one mile southwest of the park entrance.
