BIRDS

DeLeon Springs State Park, established in 1982, contains over 603 acres of prime bird watching habitat including the spring run stream, hydric hammocks, mixed forests and wet flatwoods. The park is situated near Lake Woodruff National Wildlife Refuge and Lake George Wildlife Management Area. These combined habitats and geographical locations are ideal for many species of birds and waterfowl in Central Florida, particularly during the prime viewing winter months.

The bird checklist, based on observations by Park and Refuge personnel, contains over 125 species that may be viewed at the Park throughout the year.

ETHICS FOR BIRDERS: Remember, the wild creatures are the residents here. We humans are the visitors. Take care not to disturb nesting birds, exposing eggs and young to extreme temperatures and predation.

DO NOT LITTER! Many birds die when they become entangled in fishing lines, six-pack rings and other trash, or when they mistake garbage for food. You can help by picking up these things when you come across them.
