Florida's State Tree is the Sabal Palm, *Sabal palmetto*. It is commonly called a Cabbage Palm



The State Wildflower is Coreopsis. Common names include tickseed and calliopsis.



The manatee is the state mammal. Manatees may be seen in the Spring during the winter months.
