

# Fort Pierce Inlet State Park / Avalon State Park

## Rules for the use of Metal Detectors

The use of metal detectors, for recreation purposes at Fort Pierce Inlet and Avalon State Parks, may only take place **ocean side** from the high water line (upper limit of wet sand) to the dune line where the vegetation grows.

The use of metal detectors is limited to the times of the year not designated as sea turtle nesting season. **Nesting season is from March 1<sup>st</sup> through November 30<sup>th</sup>.**

In other areas of the park, metal detectors may be used to recover personal items that are specifically identified by their owner as being lost in a specific area of the park. Management must be notified before search begins.
