

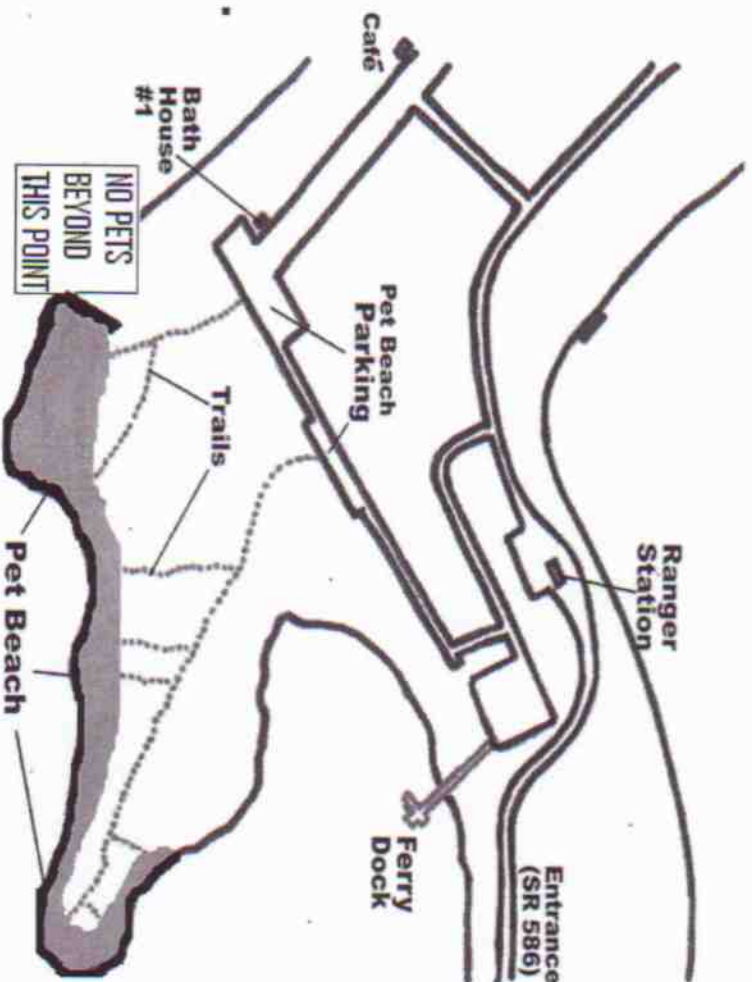
# Honeymoon Island State Park

## Pet Policy



- Pets must be kept on a maximum 6 foot handheld leash **at all times** even when in the water. The owner must remain in physical control of the pet.
- Pets are allowed on the South Beach (Pet Beach) only. Exotic animals are not permitted in the park.
- Pets are allowed in the Picnic Area, all paved inland portions of the park and on marked trails. Pets are **not** permitted on the playground, in bathing areas, park buildings, concession facilities, or sensitive habitat areas.
- Pet watering, washing station and pet waste clean-up bag dispenser are located at the Pet Beach parking area.

Service animals are welcome in all areas of Florida State Parks.



**Within Florida State Parks, it is unlawful to:**

- Leave your pet unattended in a parked vehicle;
- Let your pet out of your physical control at any time (i.e. off a handheld leash);
- Fail to pick up after your pet and properly dispose of pet droppings;
- Allow your pet to be a danger or a nuisance to other visitors.
