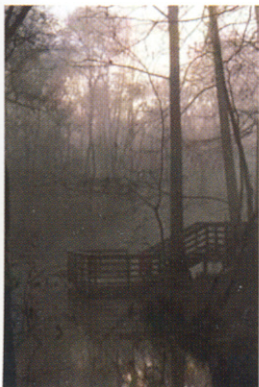


Welcome to Columbia County and the Town of Fort White. Nestled between the Santa Fe and Ichetucknee Rivers, Fort White is home to one of Florida's most pristine natural spring systems and river. Gently flowing waters and cool breezes are your companions as you wander through sections of old Florida in its untouched state. All waiting for you to enjoy at Ichetucknee Springs State Park.

New adventures await as cooler weather lends itself to many activities available within this natural preserve. Canoe, kayak, and snorkel gliding silently under winter's dormant hardwoods, past cypress lined banks, through beds of wild rice as river otters, beaver, wood ducks, and herons forage.

Hiking along upland forest trails and through sandhill communities, catch glimpses of year-round wildlife, such as whitetail deer and wild turkey, as they forage in habitats managed as part of an effort to preserve and maintain original domains of the State. For the most adventurous

visitor, a swim in the Ichetucknee River headspring's year-round 72 degree waters or a tube float along the Park's lower river will prove to be a most stimulating and memorable experience.
