Koreshan State Historic Site consists of 140 acres of land along U.S. 41 at Estero, as well as 65 acres at the mouth of the Estero River. The following is a list of vertebrate wildlife that has been recorded at these two areas and at Mound Key State Archaeological Site in Estero Bay. The habitats within and adjacent to these sites include scrubby flatwoods, pine flatwoods, mangrove swamp, tropical hammock, river, bay and mudflats.
