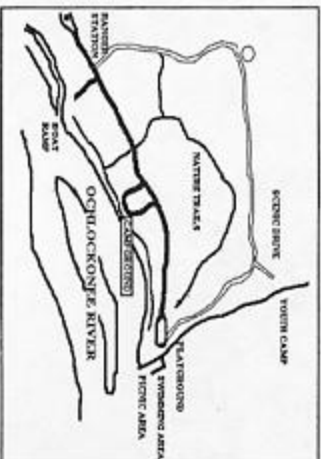

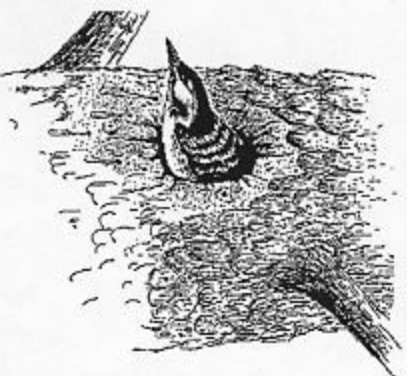

Ochlockonee River State Park is a 540 acre natural sanctuary of scenic pine flatwoods, small grass ponds and oak thickets, nestled within the St. Marks National Wildlife Refuge. In the park you may see and hear owl, deer, raccoon, fox squirrels, black bear, and the endangered Red-cockaded Woodpecker. The park staff is here to make your visit to the park pleasant.
