ST LUCIE INLET PRESERVE STATE PARK

St. Lucie Inlet Preserve State Park comprises the northern 927 acres of Jupiter Island. The park offers a unique biological and recreational experience that is rapidly vanishing from Florida.

The park abounds with bird life. Wading and shore birds can be seen throughout. During the winter, the beach is used by many species of migratory shore birds.

Upon your arrival by boat at the dock, you find yourself in an estuary. A 3,300-foot boardwalk meanders from the dock to the beach. A covered picnic pavilion and restroom facilities are located at the east end of the boardwalk near the beach.
