

# O'Leno State Park Primitive Group Camp Rental Guide

Thank you for your interest in the primitive group camps at O'Leno State Park. O'Leno State Park has three primitive group camps for rent. Each site includes restrooms, an outdoor cold-water shower, a pavilion with four picnic tables and a fire ring. Sites include access to water, however do not have electricity. **Rental Fees: \$5.00 per adult per night, \$2.00 per child (17 years of age and younger) per night.**

## Rental Guidelines

When planning your stay at O'Leno State Park, please keep the following guidelines in mind:

1. When camping with juvenile groups, at least one person 18 and older must remain with the group at all times.
2. Collection of firewood is prohibited. Please do not bring chainsaws or handsaws. You are able to purchase firewood at the ranger station if needed.
3. Please limited fires to the designated fire circle only. No fireworks.
4. Quiet hour is at 11:00pm and is strictly enforced.
5. Please do not block the trash cans. The park staff will be by each day to empty them and will need access.
6. This site comes with cold-water showers only. Bathhouses in other areas of the park are reserved for full facility campers only.
7. All plants and wildlife are protected. Please remember to take only pictures, leave nothing but footprints.

**Arrival:** Check-in is at 3 p.m. A representative of the group will need to check-in with the ranger station upon arrival. Each vehicle that will remain on site will need to register with the ranger station and obtain a parking sticker. **If your group will arrive after the park closes, please contact the ranger station at (386) 454-1853 by 5 p.m. to obtain instructions on how to access your site.**

**Departure:** Checkout is at 1 p.m. on the last day of your stay. You are welcome to continue to utilize the park for the remainder of the day, however you will need to vacate the site by checkout time. It is your responsibility to clean the facilities prior to checkout. A representative from the group will need to report to the ranger station to pay fees prior to checkout. **Please make sure to have an accurate count of the number of campers per night to report to the ranger station.**

**Programs:** Programs and service projects are available upon request. Please contact the park services specialist at (386) 454-0723 a **minimum of three weeks in advance** to request a program or a service project.

**Reservations:** Park facilities can be rented by an organized youth group up to 11 months to the day in advance. Reservations will not be taken prior to 8 a.m. Youth groups take precedence over adult groups in the primitive group camps, except that adult groups may make reservations up to 30 days in advance.

Please contact the ranger station at (386) 454-1853 for information or to make a reservation. **Rental fees are due upon checkout.**

Tax exempt organizations are required provide a copy of the organizations tax exempt certificate at the time of check-in and must pay with a check or credit card listing the same organization name as found on the tax exempt certificate. Otherwise tax will be charged.

**Cancellation of Reservations:** Cancellations should be done as soon as possible by contacting the ranger station at (386) 454-1853.

## Primitive Group Camp 1



Primitive Group Camp 1 will accommodate up to 25 people. This area offers a small picnic shelter with four picnic tables, a fire ring, outdoor cold-water showers, food preparation table with spigots, and a restroom. This site does not have electricity.

## Primitive Group Camp 2 – Sites A & B



Primitive Group Camp 2 contains two sites, labeled A and B. Each site can accommodate up to 25 people. Groups can rent one site or both, depending on their needs. The sites share a food preparation table with spigots, outdoor cold-water showers and a restroom. Each site has a small pavilion with four picnic tables and a fire ring. This site does not have electricity.
